Provincial Student Walking Distance Review

The Director of Operational Services submitted a preliminary report regarding the impact on the Tri-County Regional School Board, stemming from the 13 recommendations listed in the Provincial Student Walking Distance Review prepared by Chester Sabean.

The Director's report noted that the Board can expect a financial impact as a result of the recommendations, but since the Department of Education has not completed its assessment of the recommendations to determine what it will accept & implement, the exact financial impact on the Board cannot be determined at this point.

The report recommended that the Directors of Operational Services & Finance prepare a financial impact report for the Board after the Department of Education has completed its assessment of the recommendations.
